



of sexual misconduct involving children or young people and priests, deacons, lay employees, or volunteers serving the Diocese of Rapid City will be investigated.



still only **\$60**. For this small amount each child receives books, clothes, food, and vaccinations in addition to their education. *The commitment is to support a child for one year with prayers and the \$60 donation.*

It is a small cost for us, but a huge help for each child. The families who attend are asked to pay what they can, but many of the families have little or no money to spare. The Sisters who run the Catholic school rely on donations to make their school a reality. Over the years we have sponsored from 200 to 243 children. For the cost of an evening meal for two in a restaurant, we are able to give hope to children whose families struggle to make ends meet. Our outpouring of support through our financial gifts and our prayers is always received with great joy by the children of the Santa Luisa School. Just before Christmas, Scope Foundation sent a second donation to the Santa Luisa School to purchase 35 brand new computers for their computer lab.
