

## ST. THOMAS MORE HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT NATIONAL MERIT SEMIFINALIST



St. Thomas More would like to officially recognize Megan Achbach as a National Merit Scholarship Program Semifinalist.

The National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) announced the names of approximately 16,000 Semifinalists in the 65<sup>th</sup> annual National Merit Scholarship Program. These academically talented high school seniors have an opportunity

to continue in the competition for some 7,500 National Merit Scholarships worth more than \$31 million that will be offered next spring. Over 1.5 million juniors in about 21,000 high schools entered the 2020 National Merit Scholarship Program by taking the 2018 Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT), which served as an initial screen of program entrants. The nationwide pool of Semifinalists, representing less than one percent of US high school seniors, includes the highest-scoring entrants in each state.


To become a Finalist, the Semifinalist and his or her high school must submit a detailed scholarship application, in which they provide information about the Semifinalist's academic record, participation in school and community activities, demonstrated leadership abilities, employment, and honors and awards received. A semifinalist must have an outstanding academic record throughout high school, be endorsed and recommended by a high school official, write an essay, and earn SAT scores that confirm the student's earlier performance on the qualifying test.
