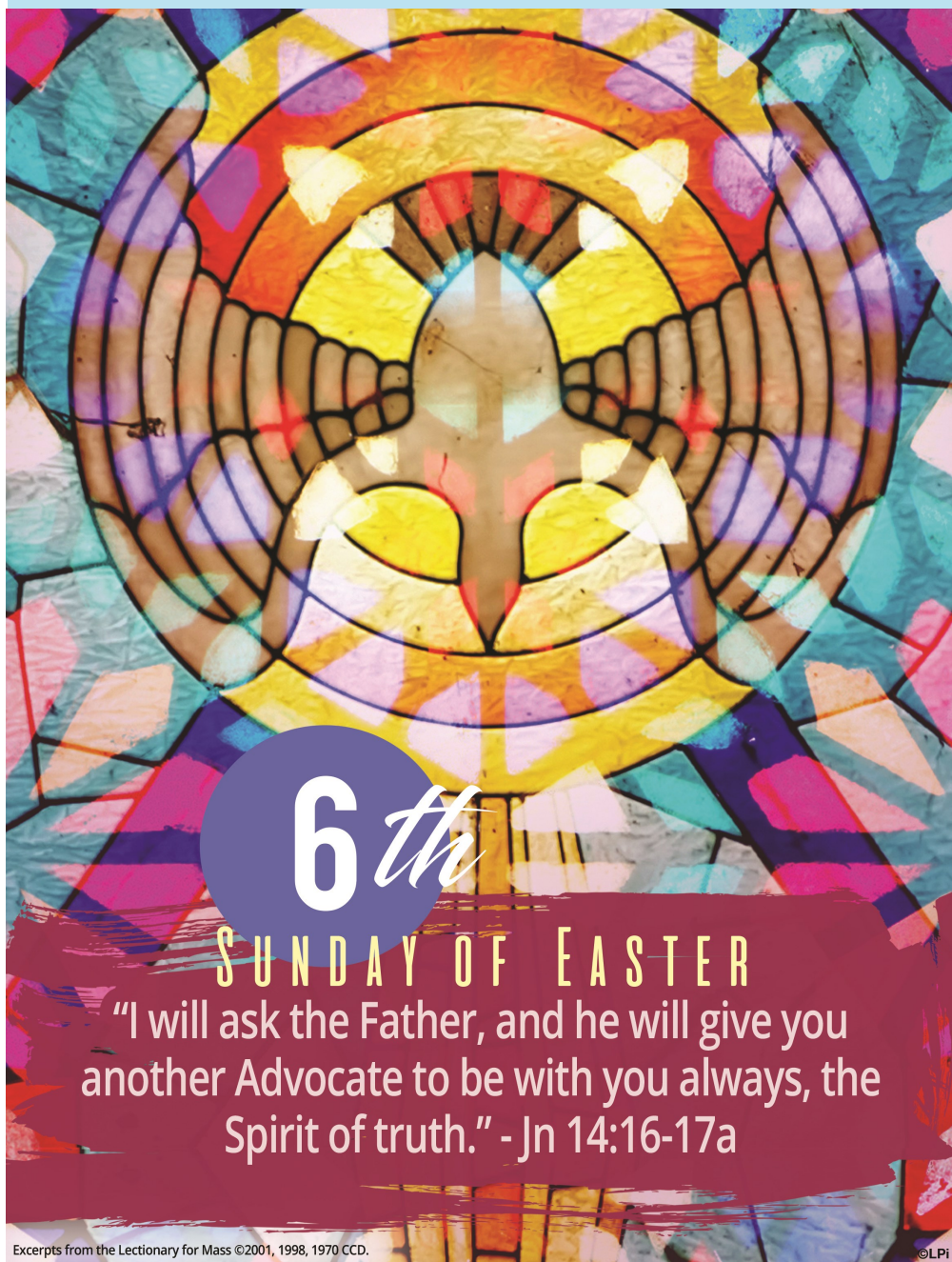

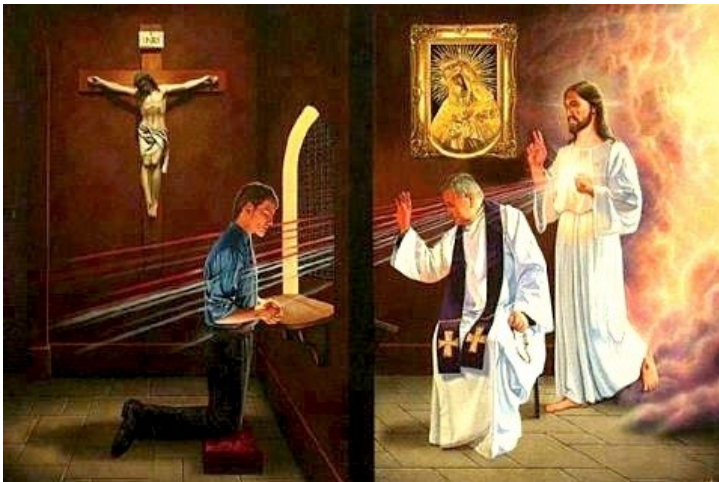

### Financial Help:

The amount of assistance per household will depend on available funding and the number of applicants. - **Department of Human Services**: Can provide emergency assistance for rent, transportation, and utilities.

The application is on the DSS website at [DSS.SD.GOV](http://DSS.SD.GOV). If approved, they will help with the one that is your main heating source.

### Meals:

- **Hope Center**: grab-and-go lunches are available Monday-Friday, 11:30 AM-1:00 PM outside the Hope Center at 615 Kansas City Street.
- **North Teen Center**: Staff will serve supper to kids Monday-Friday, 4:30-5:30 PM on site at the North Teen Center located at Bethel Assembly, 1202 N. Maple Ave.
- **Rapid City Area Schools**: grab and go breakfast, lunch, and frozen lunches to heat at home. Multiple meals will be provided at one time to ensure kids have adequate meals. They will provide food for all children 18 and under; they do not have to be enrolled. The child has to be present to receive food. Food will be served outside the main entrances by driving up or walking. Those who walk must maintain social distancing. Call Student Nutrition at 605-394-4061 for more information.

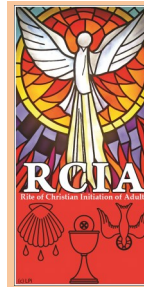
