Hesburgh Lecture: *The Wilson Sheehan Lab for Economic Opportunities (LEO): Where Academics Join Service Providers in the Fight Against Poverty*

The Notre Dame Club of the Black Hills and the Uplifting Parents Program are co-hosting this free event. The Hesburgh Lecture Series has brought Notre Dame faculty to its alumni clubs and their local communities since 1986. This year's event features William N. Evans, Ph.D., Keough-Hesburgh Professor of Economics and Co-Founder of the Wilson Sheehan Lab for Economic Opportunity (LEO). With support from the John T. Vucurevich Foundation, Dr. Evans is conducting a randomized controlled study to examine whether the Uplifting Parents Program increases college graduation rates for single parents. 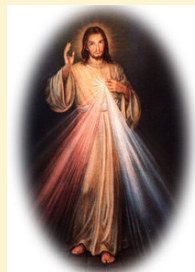
SANTA LUISA SCHOOL SPONSORSHIP

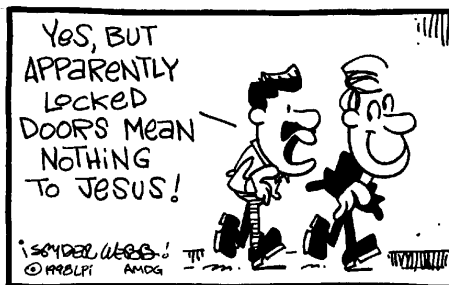
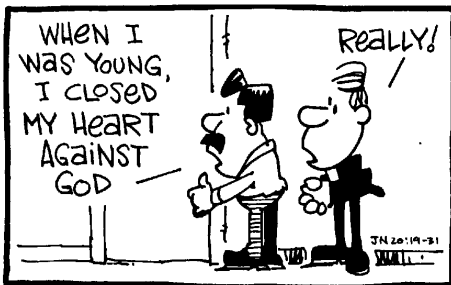
