In-pew Survey Results:

I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone for their attention and cooperation in the in-pew survey regarding the Cathedral's consideration of a potential capital campaign. I am grateful to those families who shared their input and feedback as they helped to create a comprehensive overview of the needs and opinions of our parish family.

I am excited to share with you that the in-pew survey weekend yielded a tremendous turnout with participation from over 450 parish families. The results show the majority of those surveyed had a "very positive" or "positive" overall perception of the potential campaign plans. Furthermore, it was clear that a gathering space to host expanding numbers of programs and events in the form of a Cathedral Hall Addition was the highest-ranked priority. Lastly, there was a generous indication of both volunteer time and financial commitment to a campaign, and most participants felt that now is right time for the Cathedral to embark on this journey. This is very encouraging feedback. This information will be crucial over the next couple weeks as we deeply pray about a capital campaign for the Cathedral of Our Lady of Perpetual Help and determine what that campaign may entail. Again, I thank you for your participation throughout this process.

Participants will receive weekly email or text reminders to pray and fast, along with little-known facts about Roe v. Wade to share with others.






